PRE-RACE

Porta-pots will be available near the start. Hand sanitizer will be provided inside the porta-pots. See attached Start/Finish Layout.

The race will start on time at 7:00am. Please be in the start line chute at least 5 minutes before the race starts. We will not delay the start.

Westbound Little Patuxent Parkway between Corporate Center Way and Governor Warfield Parkway will be closed by Howard County Police at 6:45am. Plan to be parked no later than 6:45am to avoid the closures. Parking in lots beyond the areas we have highlighted is at your own risk.


There will be no access to any buildings on race day. Please do not attempt to enter any buildings.



For your safety, no earbuds or pets are allowed on the course.

Strollers are permitted on the course, but please be advised that there are steep hills and narrow sections. If you are running with a stroller, please be mindful of other runners.

Please be aware that we have lots of police helping keep you safe during this event and a lot of volunteers to help ensure safety and make sure things run smoothly for your enjoyment! Please be considerate of this and if you have the energy, give a wave or say "thanks!" as you make your way past them on the course or during the post race celebration! This event wouldn't be possible without their support!





PARKING

Parking Lot 4 is the largest parking garage, has multiple entry points, and is located at 10475 Little Patuxent Pkwy, Columbia, MD 21044. We encourage you to park here. It is closest to the start and the porta pots!

The Auxiliary Lot is smaller, adjacent to The Food Market, and is located at 10500 Little Patuxent Pkwy, Columbia, MD 21044. It is available for parking as well.

Shows available parking and entry points to garages from Little Patuxent Parkway, as well as Broken Land Parkway.





COURSE INFORMATION

The Food Market 10K runs around The Mall in Columbia, along Little Patuxent Parkway, and through residential areas, with a stretch along 108. Howard County Police will take control of the course at 6:45 am. There will be cones along various parts of the course and volunteer Course Marshals with yellow vests and flags will also provide direction to runners. Edit: Prior to turning Left onto Windstream Drive, you will be veering right onto Governor Warfield Parkway from Little Patuxent Parkway. This will be well marked and with Course Marshals present.



WALKERS

Per our agreement with the Howard County Police Department, the police will provide traffic control for runners for a set period (until 9:30 am). Once the police open up the course to traffic, <u>walkers are expected to move to the sidewalk and obey the rules of the road when crossing intersections</u>. The timing mats and finish line chute will remain open to score all participants.

Walkers who fail to move onto the sidewalk or follow the rules of the road may be DISQUALIFIED.

ON COURSE AID STATIONS

There will be two aid stations on the course. The first will be around Mile 2 on Columbia Road and the second one will be around Mile 4 on West Running Brook. Feel free to bring your own hydration, as well. Please see the course map for approximate locations along the course.

The awards ceremony will be held at the post-race celebration around 8:30 am. If you believe that you have won an overall or age group award, please stay on-site after you finish to claim your award. There will be no "double dipping" and participants are only eligible for one award.

POST-RACE CELEBRATION

As you finish, there will be tubs of bottled water available as you cool down in the courtyard.

The post-race celebration will be hosted by The Food Market in their new outdoor area where they will have various breakfast food stations set up. You will need to show your bib at the entrance where you will also receive a drink ticket upon entry. **Bibs must be visible for food and drink!** Your registration includes one drink ticket. Additional drinks are also available for purchase in the bar area of The Food Market. If you choose to stick around for a seated meal as the post-race celebration winds down, the restaurant will be open for seating at 10 am.

Enjoy the chef curated spread, drinks, and music while you lounge in the courtyard or mosey around to visit our sponsor and beneficiary tables.
